Purpose of the Position: The RTI teacher provides for programming, support and instruction for students in grades K-6 who meet the NDE and Loup City Public Schools RTI and SAT guidelines

Supervisor: Elementary School Principal

Qualifications:

- Undergraduate degree from an accredited college / university
- Nebraska Teaching License on file in the Central Office
- Highly Qualified Status according to NCLB Guidelines
- All required district forms on file in the Superintendent's Office
- Training in *Reading Mastery* and *Saxon Math* preferred
- Experience in tutoring or teaching skills

Performance Responsibilities:

- Co-ordinates, directs, and schedules RTI / SAT program for grades K-6
- Provides instruction and accommodations for RTI / SAT program in grades K-6
- Serves as a proctor for M.A.P. and NeSA tests
- Meets with SAT teams as needed to problem solve for students
- Maintains accurate files detailing RTI/SAT interventions and plans
- With counselor, provides for transition between elementary and Junior-Senior High grade levels
- In conjunction with school counselor and administrators, identifies students who are at risk and communicates with teachers and administration
- Develops individual plans to support success for RTI students with the student support (SAT) teams
- Monitors and modifies RTI / SAT interventions based on data and evaluation
- Develops appropriate interventions to facilitate learning for RTI / SAT students
- Monitors, collects data, and provides feedback to teachers to maintain ensure curricular alignment to Nebraska State Standards
- Collects data and provides feedback to ensure fidelity to program design in reading and math
- Performs other duties as assigned by the building principal
