

**WALL OF FAME SELECTION CRITERIA
ALUMNI AWARD**

1. The nominations shall consist of a completed nomination form available upon request from the Superintendent's Office at Loup City High School or from the Loup City Public School's website. The Selection Committee may request additional information about the nominee.
2. Nominations shall be kept on file by the Selection Committee to be considered each subsequent year. The nominations will be due by April 1st of each year.
3. In order to qualify as a candidate for the Wall of Fame Alumni Award, the individual shall be at least a 20-year graduate and have completed high school studies at Loup City High School or feeder schools.
4. Qualifying candidates for the Alumni Award shall have made a significant, lasting contribution to society; have exhibited good citizenship; demonstrated outstanding leadership; and have high moral character.
5. Records shall be kept, consisting of a resume and, if available, a picture of all individuals selected for the Alumni Award. These records will be kept with the Alumni Association records in the Superintendent's Office.
6. A nominee must receive at least two-thirds vote from the entire selection committee to be honored. In the event more than the number eligible receive the two-thirds vote, each selection committee member will rank those receiving the two-thirds vote, with number "one" being their top nominee. The person(s) with the lowest numerical score will be the one(s) honored on the Wall of Fame.
7. A nomination that is not chosen will be left on file for five years.
